At the same time, the joy and innocence of Marlene attract him. A desire shivers through his body, encouraged by the attitude of the young woman. Or is it a delusion ? Frédéric is going through a bad patch because of his marriage with Nicole. He's at a turning-point. His short amorous meeting with Marlene foretells the tragic ending of the story.
